



Car Shows for Charity®

Judges Instruction

Plan your time - How much time divided by # cars

Team members work together to determine and agree on point deductions for each part judged or divide the sections up between members. Consistency is our goal.

Confirm correct classification Late Model (LM) or Classic (CL)

Judging sheet – Complete Thoroughly. Enter points to deduct and check **condition, workmanship, cleanliness**. Originality, color, rarity of car, modifications, other display items are **not** a factor.

HOODS OPEN... If hood closed take off all points for engine...

CLEANLINESS is serious point deduction; dust from show field is not. Examine the difficult to clean areas for dirt. Engine area, look at underside of hood and liner, hood hinges, core support for dust near radiator, behind horns. Look for grit in the depressions of the intake manifold. Interior, look for dust on console and below the rear window. Glass should be spotless.

CONDITION may also be point deduction for neglected areas. Are any metal surfaces rusted or corroded? Late model cars often have rust on upper tip of struts or visible on edges of rotor. These may be from factory but they are a deduction. The manufacture did not build a show car, but some owners will correct these issues and make the car more presentable for a show.
